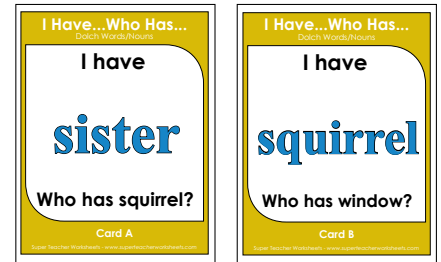


I Have...Who Has...

Dolch Words/ Nouns

How to play the game:

- Distribute the cards randomly to your students. Some students may get more than one card.
- Select a student to begin by reading their card aloud. (example: I have sister. Who has squirrel?)
- The student who has the card with the correct answer to the previous student's "Who Has..." question reads their card aloud. (example: I have squirrel. Who has window?) And so on.
- Students must listen for their turn and try not to break the chain.
- When the chain circles around to the first student, the game is over.



Suggestions:

- Print out the "I Have, Who Has" flashcards on card stock and laminate them so they will last for many years to come.
- Practice the game once with your students so they understand how the game works, then see if they can "beat the timer." Set a timer for 2 minutes, 5 minutes, or any amount of time you choose. Challenge them to finish the game before the timer goes off.

Answer Chain:

A: I have sister. Who has squirrel?

B: I have squirrel. Who has window?

C: I have window. Who has birthday?

D: I have birthday. Who has children?

E: I have children. Who has picture?

F: I have picture. Who has morning?

G: I have morning. Who has school?

H: I have school. Who has sheep?

I: I have sheep. Who has farmer?

J: I have farmer. Who has flower?

K: I have flower. Who has garden?

L: I have garden. Who has paper?

M: I have paper. Who has robin?

N: I have robin. Who has bread?

O: I have bread. Who has apple?

P: I have apple. Who has father?

Q: I have father. Who has rabbit?

R: I have rabbit. Who has mother?

S: I have mother. Who has song?
